## Arts Integration Core Team Offerings

A team consisting of Chautauqua Institution, Jamestown Public Schools and Chautauqua Lake Central School was honored in 2016 as one of 10 new inductees in the Kennedy Center Partners in Education Program. Inspired by the partnership, this team now offers arts integrated professional development workshops for area educators. Arts integration provides a differentiated approach to teaching and learning that can inspire, engage and motivate teachers and students alike through collaborative and creative learning in the classroom.

### This program provides:

- 4 workshops on arts integrated strategies, using a hybrid of in-person, asynchronous content and Zoom meetings
  - *Sean Layne, Acting Right: Building Collaborative Classroom Culture* (In-person workshop on September 27)
  - *Melanie Rick, Reading Art as a Foundation* (Asynchronous content followed by Zoom workshop on December 2)
  - *Sean Layne, Curriculum-based Tableau* (Remote, 2 hour workshop on January 31 — must have attended Acting Right to participate)
  - *Melanie Rick, Reading Art as Approach to Teaching* (In-person workshop on March 7 — must have attended Reading Art as Foundation to participate)
- Access to view demonstration sessions using each of the above strategies with Chautauqua County students
- Virtual check-ins with Sean and Melanie, who will help team members implement these strategies in their own classrooms
- Community-building support network of like-minded colleagues
- 15 hours of CTLE credit total for all sessions

Team members are highly encouraged to attend all provided sessions – those that attend all will be invited to a reception and concert event at Chautauqua Institution during the summer of 2022.

For those who prefer attending just individual workshops without the additional curricular support, an “a la carte” option will be provided.
