Your membership makes it possible for Chautauqua to attract exceptional dance students from around the country.

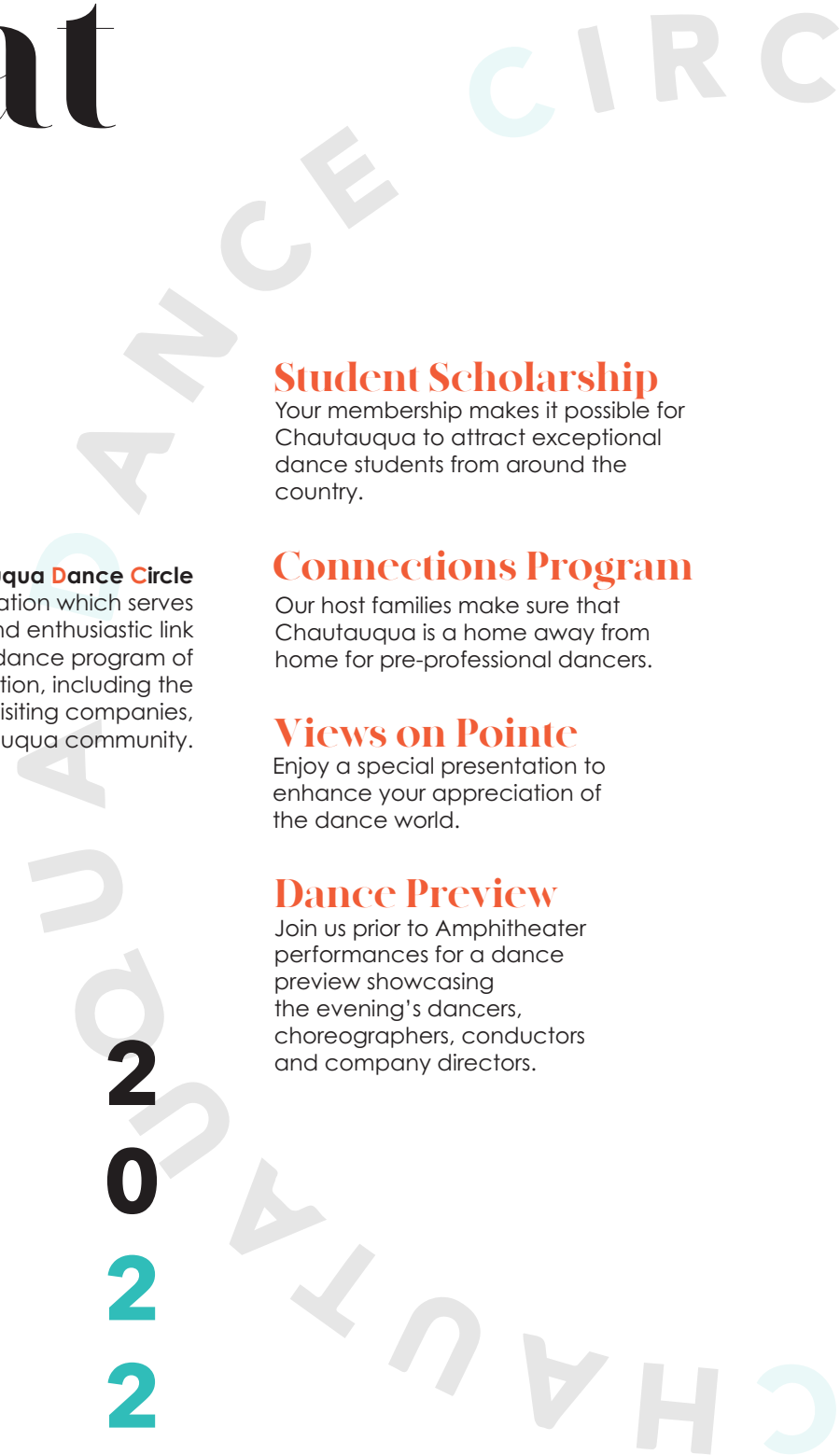

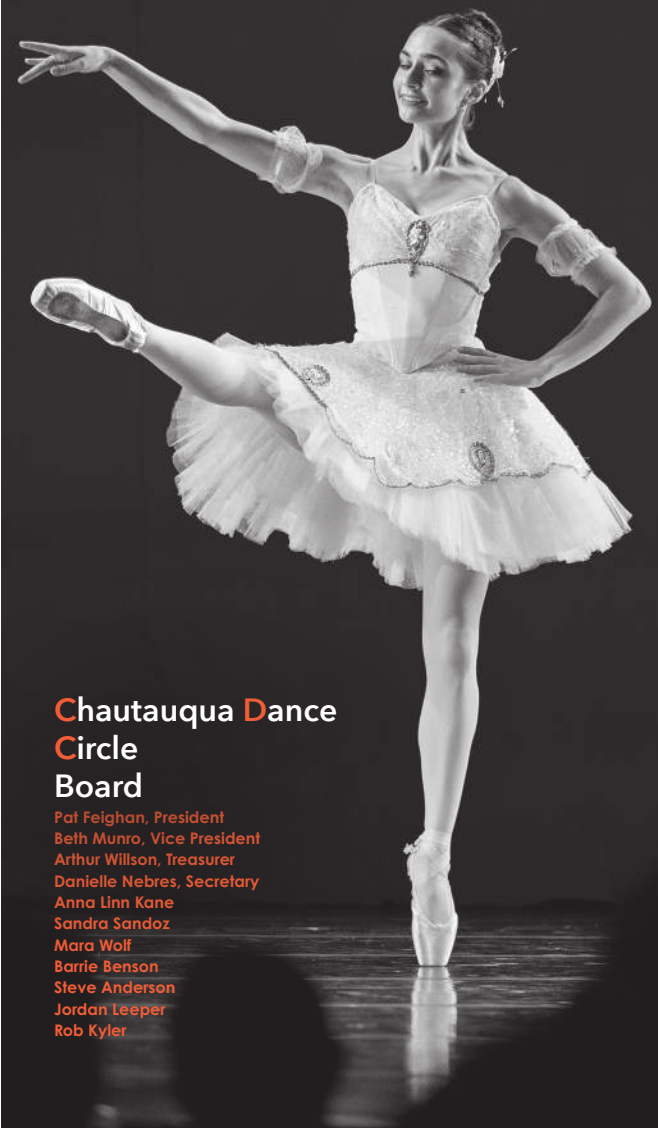
